Challenging Behavior Definition Sentence Starters

Purpose: Teams or individuals can use these sentence starters when operationally defining a student's challenging behavior. Use the phrase in the Operational Definition Stem column to start the definition and add in student-specific information.

Behavior Label	Operational Definition Stem
Disruptive Behavior	Behaviors that interfere with his/her learning or the learning of those around him/her
Leaving Designated Area/ Elopement	Successful and/or unsuccessful attempts to leave the designated area without adult supervision and/or permission to include
Inappropriate Commenting	Verbal comment/statements directed at peers or adults that may be argumentative or hurtful in nature to include
Off Task	Engaging in behaviors other than the expected behavior/task (for longer than amount of time) to include
Physical Aggression (can specify towards peers or adults)	Physical contact with self, others, and/or property that is potentially harmful in nature to include
Refusal	Verbal or nonverbal refusal to comply with an adult-given directive (within_amount of time). Examples to include
Property Destruction	Successful and/or unsuccessful attempts to damage personal or public property to include
Tantrum	An episode lasting at least (amount of time) that may include the following behaviors
Use of Profanity	Vocalizations consisting of vulgarities or expletives or words that are not age appropriate. Examples to include
